Goyt Valley 21 (GV21) is one of the most beautiful walks in the High Peak - and all in the Parish of Whaley Bridge. The '21' is kilometres - about 13 miles - starting at St James' Church, Taxal, proceeding up to Windgather Rocks, then on to Cat's Torr and the Cat and Fiddle pub.

From there, it's mostly downhill to Errwood and Fernilee reservoirs, then back to St James' for hot soup and a sandwich.

Your entry fee and sponsorship pledges will go towards the Parish Magazine production costs, as we seek to reach out to more and more in the community.
